REQUIREMENTS: Dress and booth should be 19th century era if feasible.

GENERAL: All boxes and containers must be kept out of sight. Please remember that this is an outside event.
 Each exhibitor's area must always be kept clean, and trash can be placed in the provided dumpsters.
 Tables must be covered to the ground in front and on sides.
 Security is provided after dark on Friday and Saturday Nights. Please do not bring pets.
 Ice and firewood will be provided for purchase on site. Please speak with a TSHF representative on how to acquire.
 Exhibitors must provide their own tables, chairs, display racks and all equipment.
 No items may be offered for sale that may be considered dangerous, harmful, or could be considered littering (silly string, poppers, exploding devices). There are to be no items that promote violence, nudity, or are offensive to the public. It is at the chairperson's discretion as to any item in question. Anyone found selling the above items will be asked to remove them or be removed and banned from TSHF at once with no refund.
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE PROHIBITED IN CITY PARKS.
 There are restrooms on site and showers available at the Tiffin YMCA across the street from the village.
