REQUIREMENTS: Dress and booth should be relevant to your demonstration/ reenactor's time period.

RULES: All boxes and containers must be kept out of sight. Please remember that this is an outside event.

Each exhibitor's area must always be kept clean, and trash can be placed in the provided trash cans.

Tables must be covered to the ground in front and on sides.

Ice and firewood will be provided on site. Please speak with a TSHF representative on how to acquire.

Exhibitors must provide their own tables, chairs, display racks and all equipment.

No items may be offered for sale that may be considered dangerous, harmful, or could be considered littering (silly string, poppers, exploding devices). There are to be no items that promote violence, nudity, or are offensive to the public. It is at the chairperson's discretion as to any item in question. Anyone found selling the above items will be asked to remove them or be removed and banned from TSHF at once with no refund.

There are restrooms on site. Shower facilities will be available.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE PROHIBITED IN CITY PARKS.

The concessionaire agrees:

- 1. As partial consideration for being allowed to participate in the Tiffin-Seneca Heritage Festival (TSHF) in Tiffin, Ohio that they are an independent contractor and not an agent for the committee.
